

**OFFICIAL CALL**  
**LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT MASS MEETING**  
**OF THE 10<sup>TH</sup> HOUSE DISTRICT OF THE REPUBLICAN PARTY OF VIRGINIA**

As Chairman of the 10<sup>th</sup> House of Delegates Legislative District Committee of the Republican Party, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Eugene W. Hairston, Jr., do hereby issue this call for a 10<sup>th</sup> House of Delegates Legislative District Mass Meeting to be held at the Henry County Administration Building, located at 3300 Kings Mountain Road, Martinsville, Virginia on Friday, June 5, 2009 beginning at 7:00 p.m., registration beginning at 6:30 p.m., for the purpose of (a) nominating a Republican Candidate to the House of Delegates to be voted for in the general election on November 3, 2009; and (b) for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the convention.

**QUALIFICATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION**

All legal and qualified voters under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin, or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions, or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, unless otherwise stipulated by the appropriate Official Committee, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party after March 1, 2004 or in the last five years whichever is more recent.

A single exception to the above paragraph shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that he/she is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends, at the time of writing, to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future. Any voter that utilizes the foregoing exception, and thereafter participates in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party, shall not have the benefit of this exception thereafter.

A person who has made application and meets all other requirements of the Qualifications for Participation, but whose name does not appear on the local registration books solely because of the books having been closed in connection with a local election, will nevertheless be deemed a legal and qualified voter.

All persons wishing to participate in the Mass Meeting must present themselves with identification during registration times listed above to verify and receive their credentials. Those in line at the close of registration shall be permitted to register, but no one shall join the line after 7:00 p.m.

**FILING REQUIREMENTS**

Candidates for the Republican nomination for the House of Delegates, 10th District, to be chosen at the Mass Meeting, shall file a written statement of intent to the attention of Chip Hairston that must be received (postmark does not count) on or before 5:00 p.m., Monday, June 1, 2009 at 1601 Virginia Avenue, Martinsville VA 24112-9541. No Mass meeting will be held in the event that a) no candidate properly files; or b) only one candidate properly files, in which instance said candidate shall be declared the Republican Nominee.

**REGISTRATION FEE**

There shall be no registration fee to participate in this Mass Meeting.
