OFFICIAL CALL Mass Meeting of the Republican Party of Hampton City Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Republican Party of Hampton City Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Kyle P. Adams, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at Hampton City Hall, City Council Chambers, 8th Floor, at 22 Lincoln Street, Hampton, VA 23669, or its alternate site, starting at 6:00 pm local time on Monday, April 5, 2010 for the following purposes:

1. To Elect up to 90 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia First Congressional District Convention to be held at Caroline County High School, at 19155 Rogers Clark, Millford, VA 22514, or its alternate site, starting at 1:00 pm, with registration beginning at 11:00 am, local time, on May 15, 2010 for the purposes of electing a Congressional District Chairman. Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per (500) Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that the Republican Party of Hampton City Committee is entitled to 18 Delegate Votes;
2. To Elect up to 370 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia Second Congressional District Convention to be held at the Cleveland Street Bingo Building, at 7933 Cleveland Street, Virginia Beach, VA 23462, or its alternate site, on May 8, 2010 starting at 11:00 am, local time, for the purposes of electing a Congressional District Chairman. Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per (250) Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that the Republican Party of Hampton City Committee is entitled to 74 Delegate Votes;
3. To Elect up to 140 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia Third Congressional District Convention to be held at the Hilton Garden Inn, at 441 International Center Drive, Sandston, VA, or its alternate site, on May 22, 2010 starting at 1:00 pm, local time, for the purposes of electing a Congressional District Chairman and to select a Republican Nominee for the Third Congressional District. Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per (250) Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that the Republican Party of Hampton City Committee is entitled to 28 Delegate Votes;
4. To elect a Unit Chairman of the Republican Party of Hampton City Committee, and members to the said Unit Committee;
5. And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Mass Meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters, of the City of Hampton, under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

Pre-Filing Requirements

Candidates for the election as a Delegate or Alternate Delegate to the First, Second, or Third District Conventions and/or as Members of the Republican Party of Hampton City Committee at said Mass Meeting shall file a written Notice of Candidacy Form for District Convention / Committee Membership transmitted via mail, postmarks shall not govern, or in person, to Chairman Kyle P. Adams at 1561 Briarfield Road, Suite I, Hampton, Virginia 23666 or by email at kpadams518@verizon.net and accompanied by any fees as noted below no later than 5:00 pm, local time, March 22, 2010. Official Notice of Candidacy Form will be available from Chairman Kyle P. Adams at (757) 218-2791 or may be downloaded at www.rpv.org or www.hamptonvagop.org .

Candidates for the election of Unit Chairman at said Mass Meeting shall file a written Notice of Candidacy Form for Unit Chairman transmitted via mail, postmarks shall not govern, or in person, to Chairman Kyle P. Adams at 1561 Briarfield Road, Suite I, Hampton, Virginia 23666 or by email at kpadams518@verizon.net and accompanied by any fees as noted below no later than 5:00 pm, local time, seven (7) days after the publication date of this Call. Official Notice of Candidacy Form for Unit Chairman will be available from Chairman Kyle P. Adams at (757) 218-2791 or may be downloaded at www.rpv.org or www.hamptonvagop.org .

Only those who have properly Pre-Filed can be nominated at the Mass Meeting. If no more than one candidate files for election to the office of Unit Chairman to be voted upon at the Mass Meeting, that candidate will be declared duly elected.

Participation and Pre-Filing Fees

All candidates for Unit Chairman are required to submit \$50.00 Pre-Filing fee.

All candidates for City Committee Member are required to submit \$15.00 annual dues, first year.

A voluntary fee is requested of all candidates for Delegate or Alternate Delegate to the First District Convention of \$10.00.

A voluntary fee is requested of all candidates for Delegate or Alternate Delegate to the Third District Convention of \$20.00.

A voluntary fee of \$5.00 is requested to participate in this Mass Meeting

Fees are requested to be paid by check or money order, payable to the Republican Party of Hampton City Committee. Required fees are to be paid at the time of filing. Voluntary fees may be paid at the attendance of the Mass Meeting.
