

OFFICIAL CALL FOR
Highland County Mass Meeting of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Highland County Committee of the Republican Party, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Philip G. Munchel, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the Monterey fire house, starting at 6:00 PM local time on March 25, 2010 for the following purpose:

1. Electing up to 30 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia 6th District Convention to be held in Towns Alumni Center at Liberty University, 1971 University Blvd, Lynchburg, VA on Saturday, May 22, 2010 10:00 a.m. The purpose of the District Convention is to elect a District Chairman of the Sixth District Republican Committee and three regional Vice-Chairmen. Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per (250) Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that Highland County is entitled to 6 Delegate Votes;
2. Elect a unit chair and members of the committee

And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

Registration Fee

There will be no registration fee to participate in the Mass Meeting but voluntary donations of Ten Dollars \$10 or more, to offset the costs of the Mass Meeting, will be accepted.
