

OFFICIAL CALL
Mass Meeting of the CARROLL COUNTY REPUBLICAN COMMITTEE of the
REPUBLICAN PARTY OF VIRGINIA

As Chairperson of the **Carroll County Committee of the Republican Party**, and Pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Carolyn H. Honeycutt, do hereby issue this **call for a Mass Meeting** to be held at the **Carroll County Governmental Center, 605 Pine Street, Hillsville, VA 24343 in the Board of Supervisors Meeting Room, Second Floor, starting at 6:30 P.M. local time on Monday, March 15, 2010** for the following purposes:

- 1.** Electing up to **270 Delegates** and an equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia 9th District Convention to be held at Fort Chiswell High School, #1 Pioneer Trail, Max Meadows, Virginia 24360 or its alternative site, on May 22, 2010 starting at 10:00 A.M. for the purposes of electing a Congressional District Chairman and nominating a Republican candidate for the House of Representatives. Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per (250) Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that Carroll County Committee is entitled to **54 Delegate Votes**;
- 2.** To elect a unit chairman, vice chairman, vice-chairwoman, treasurer, secretary and members to the unit committee.

And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

All legal and qualified voters under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, **who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for the public office in the ensuing election**, may participate as the members of the Republican Party of Virginia in the mass meetings, party canvases, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

No pre-filing or filing fee is required for this mass meeting.
